Daily Care of Your Caesarstone Quartz Surface

Caesarstone's durable finish requires only simple and routine care and maintenance. For daily cleaning we recommend using warm water and a mild detergent or quality spray-andwipe type cleaner such as Windolene® in order to enjoy a pristine countertop for years to come. Unlike other stone surfaces, Caesarstone requires no polishing or sealing to renew its lustre, providing you with a virtually maintenance-free surface.

Stubborn Marks or Dried Spills

In order to safely remove adhered material such as food, gum, nail polish or dried paint, first scrape off excess material with a Stanley blade or plastic putty knife at a 45 degree angle. Then use a damp cloth to remove any marks or residual dirt. For removal of stubborn marks like tea, coffee and red wine use a non-scratch (usually pink and white in colour) Scotch-Brite® pad along with a non-abrasive cleanser such as Caesarstone's cream cleanser or liquid Chemico® household cleaner (in the bottle, not the tub). The Caesarstone cream cleanser is available from any International Slab Sales branch.

Scratch Resistance

Our quartz surfaces are highly scratch resistant, but not indestructible. In order to retain your countertop's smooth finish, refrain from using sharp objects such as sharp knives or screw drivers directly onto the surface. We recommend always using a chopping board for food preparation or other work involving sharp tools.

Heat Tolerance

Caesarstone's quartz surfaces are heat resistant and not affected by temperatures lower than 100°C, however, prolonged, direct contact or radiated heat from hot pots and pans can cause thermal shock, discolouring or damage to any stone material. We recommend always using a trivet for hot objects and that they never be placed directly onto the surface.

Cleaning Agents to Avoid

It's important to be aware that like any other surface, Caesarstone's quartz surfaces can be permanently damaged if exposed to strong chemicals and solvents that can damage their physical properties. Never clean your Caesarstone surface with products that contain Trichlorethane or Methylene Chloride, such as paint removers or strippers. Avoid the use of highly aggressive cleaning agents such as oven or grill cleaners and dishwasher polishing agents that have high alkaline or pH levels (pH 8.5 or higher). Products containing oils or powders may leave a residue and should be rinsed off thoroughly. Should your surface accidentally be exposed to any of these damaging products, rinse immediately with clean water to neutralise the effect.
